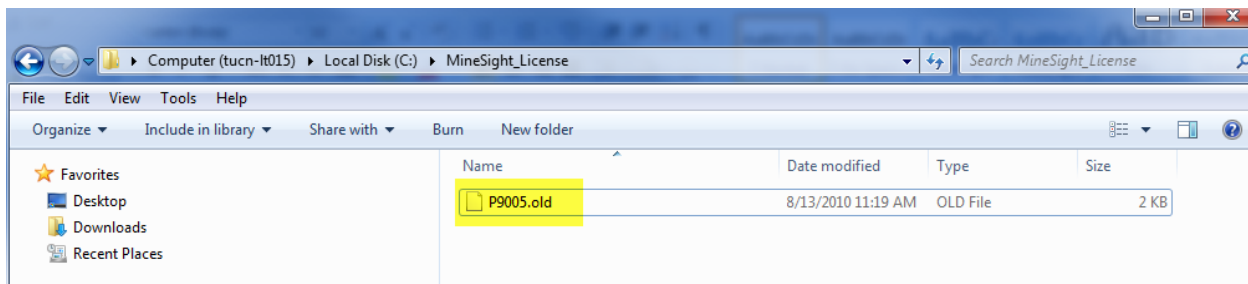


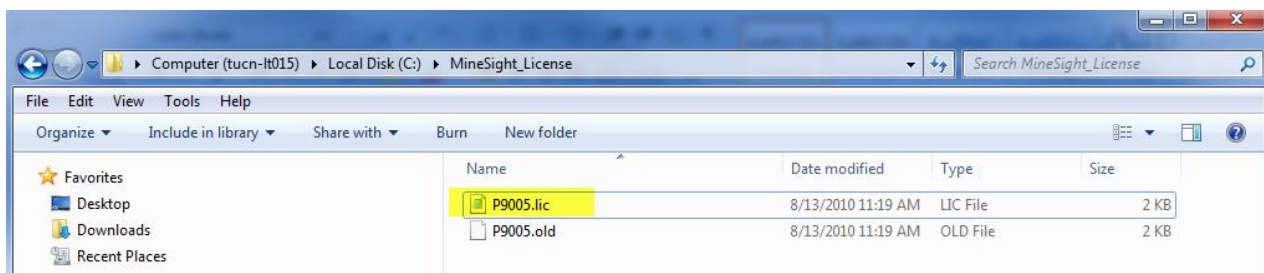
Updating a Standalone MineSight Package License

Each year, after maintenance payments are received, Mintec/MineSight Applications will send a new license file for each standalone key. This new license file is required in order to use updates released in the coming year. Please use the following instructions to update your package license.

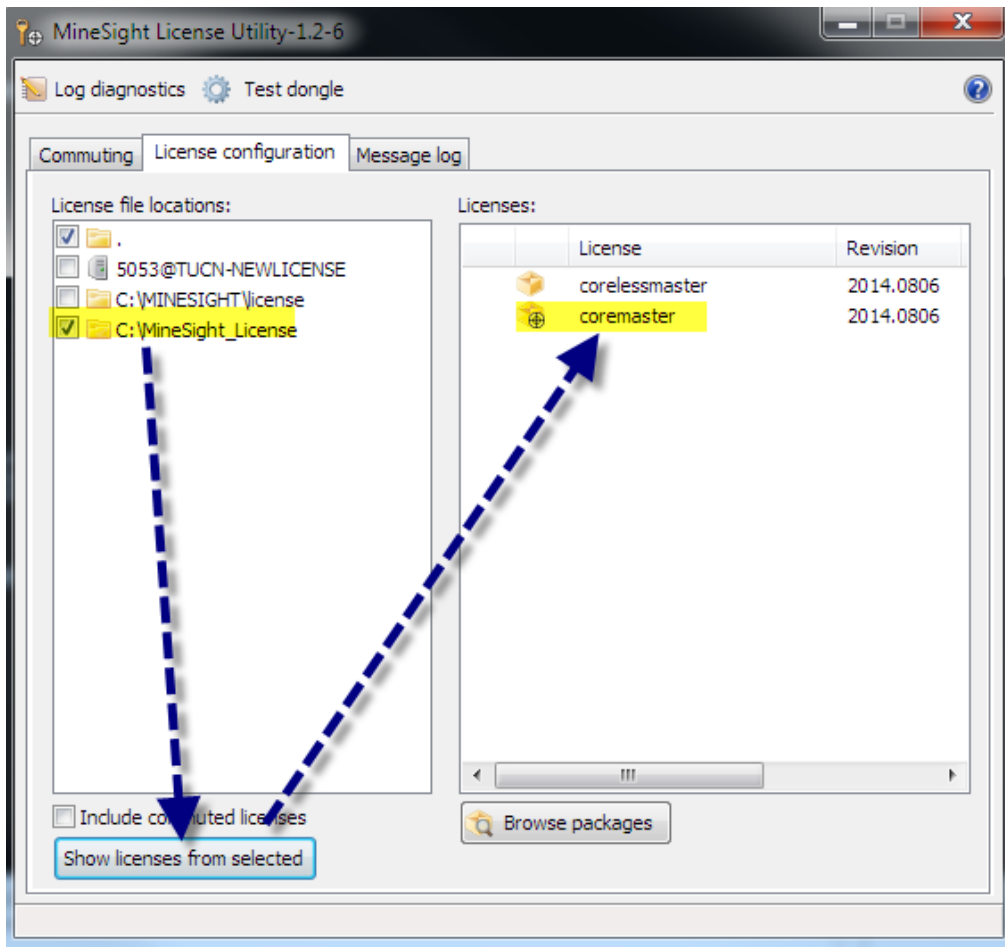
1. Close MineSight and any associated programs
2. Navigate to the folder where your license file is stored (%MEDEXE%\license or C:\MineSight_License). Note that %MEDEXE% is the value of the environmental variable MEDEXE, if MEDEXE=H:\programs\MineSight, then %MEDEXE%=H:\programs\MineSight.
3. Rename the old license file with the *.old extension.
 - a. Renaming is preferable to deletion as we can easily restore the old license if necessary.
 - b. Renaming is required because otherwise the expiration dates of the license would conflict and the license will show as invalid.



4. Copy the new license file into the license folder:



To check that the file has been updated, you can open the MineSight New Licensing Utility (Start→Programs→MineSight→MineSight New Licensing Utility). Navigate to the “License Configuration” tab, check the box corresponding to the license location, and click the “Show Licenses from Selected” button. You should see the updated revision date in the panel (see picture on next page).
